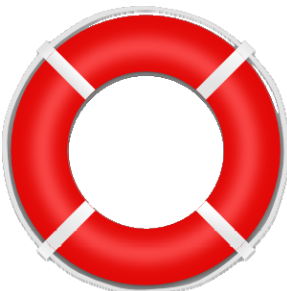

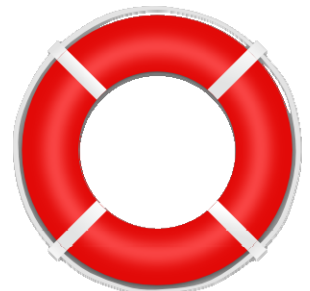
Paint Chip Wheel MIA
