Being a good neighbor???

- Do remember to bring in your trashcans within 24 hours of pickup.
- Do fix your fence before it falls
- Do paint your fence if it needs it
- Do keep your grass cut, edged & watered
- Do trim your trees to 7' above the sidewalk
- Do keep your yard mostly grass, not weeds
- Do keep the sidewalk cleared for residents to walk on as they pass your house. If the car blocks it, it is hard to get a stroller around the obstruction.

POOL Information

POOL RULES

- No Swimming Alone is allowed in the pool.
- No Children under 14 without an adult in attendance. Children under 14 years of age must be supervised by their parent or other adult permitted user (18 years or older). Parent/Adult supervisor is expected to supervise their children and be responsible for and liable for the actions of the children.
- Do not abuse, misuse or damage the pool facility or contents.
- No RUNNING, PUSHING, or other rough play is allowed inside the pool fence.
- No GLASS containers are allowed inside the pool fence.
- No DIVING, the pool is not designed to accommodate diving.
- No large floatation devices, such as air mattresses, inner tubes, rafts, etc. are allowed in the pool.
- No loud music at the pool area, volume of your personal music must be kept low enough not to disturb other pool users or adjacent homeowners.
- Suntan and other oils are not permitted in the water.
- No abusive, obscene, vulgar or profane language or other actions will be tolerated at the pool.
- As a courtesy to all, everyone is asked to leave the pool area in an orderly condition and pick up and dispose
 of trash in a proper receptacle before leaving the pool area.
- The pool gate must be closed and locked after entering or leaving the pool area.

Pool Hours

10am - 9pm Monday thru Thursday

10am - 10pm Friday thru Sunday

Violations of these rules may result in the suspension of the homeowners swimming pool privileges. No allowances made in dues amount if a suspension occurs.
