CODES CORNER

City of Prairie Village

The goals of the City's Code Enforcement program are to protect neighborhoods against blight and deteriorating influences, maintain property values and protect the health and safety of our residents. Below are just a few city codes to help maintain property values and community safety. A more complete list of

- Prairie Village has many, many miles of sidewalks, which are utilized for recreational and necessary pedestrian travel. The City asks your cooperation to help keep these sidewalks clear, safe, and accessible to all who use them. Please check the sidewalk abutting your property and maintain it on a regular basis for leaves, limbs, sweet gum balls, acorns, snow, and other debris. Pedestrians have fallen due to debris on the sidewalk, have been injured due to low hanging limbs, fallen or had to walk in the street due to snow. Please help to make our sidewalks safe and accessible to all.
- As Fall comes upon us leaves pile up. When raking your leaves please do not forget to rake up the leaves and debris that are in the street curbing in front of your house. Leaves and other debris, if not picked up, can wash into the drainage basins and be a contributing cause of flooding.
- Trash cans must be stored behind the front building line and screened from view of the street. Trashcans are big and ugly; no one wants to look at them in front of your house. <u>Please make arraignments to store your trashcans out of sight according to city code.</u>
- Regular trimming is an important part of keeping trees healthy. We have had years of harsh weather extremes
 and hard economic times. Tree maintenance can be expensive, but it is very important to the safety of your
 property and to surrounding properties. Check the trees on your property to see if conditions exist, which
 could be harmful. You might check with other residents on your street who need tree trimming to see about
 getting better pricing with a tree company to do several properties at once.

Working together as a community is the best way to preserve, protect and promote the stability and value of our neighborhoods and our city.
