CURBSIDE LEAF PICK-UP



Fall is here! Our trees are changing color and will soon be dropping their leaves. Do you have a plan for cleaning them up?

PVHA members may sign-up for curbside leaf pick-up. This is an optional, fee-forservice program. A sign-up form including the fee schedule and instructions can be found on page 2 of this newsletter.

Participating members can rake their leaves to the curb and have them vacuumed up on the 2nd Sundays in Nov. & Dec. As a courtesy to your neighbors, please move your leaves to the curb just before the pick-up date. This service is designed to handle the majority of your leaves. You will likely need to rake & bag between pick-ups as well.

- used items*: ☐ Clothing and outerwear for all seasons ☐ Accessories - jewelry, belts, shoes, pocketbooks, scarves, ties, hats ☐ Linens - blankets, sheets, towels, curtains, drapes ☐ Housewares - dishes, silverware, pots, pans, baskets, tins, glassware (please package carefully) ☐ Books--but no textbooks, encyclopedias or Reader's Digest ☐ Small electronics--Stereos (except consoles), computers, monitors, printers, toasters, irons ☐ Electronics-clock radios, tape players, mp3 players,
- speakers
- ☐ Lamps & Furniture but no rusty, stained or worn
- ☐ Mechanical items bikes, lawnmowers, weed whackers
- ☐ Records, tapes, CDs
- ☐ Fabric, sewing supplies, notions

*Goodwill representatives make the final decision on what is acceptable. They no longer repair items.

Items that will not be accepted:

- ☐ Auto parts tires, batteries
- ☐ Venetian blinds, curtain rods

Curbside Leaf Pick-up!

The Prairie Village Homes Association has arranged for Benjamin Lawn & Landscape, LLC to offer a group rate for residential curbside leaf removal in our neighborhood for the fall of 2014. This is a voluntary program with the following pick-up options:

	Date	Cost	Combined cost for both
Pick-up #1	Sunday, November 9th, 2014	\$37	\$65/both
Pick-up #2	Sunday, December 14th, 2014	\$47	\$65/both

Guidelines

- Please have leaves ready for pick-up by 8 A.M. Sunday morning. Pick-up may occur anytime on Sunday morning Monday afternoon.
- Benjamin Lawn & Landscape trucks are equipped with a side mount vacuum that is designed to pull alongside a long row of leaves. Please rake leaves into a pile along the curb (edge of the lawn) that is as long and narrow as possible. The machines can reach 6 feet into the yard so leaves beyond 6 feet may not be removed.
- Leaves should be raked up to the edge of the lawn as noted above. <u>It is very important that you DO NOT rake leaves into the street or gutter and DO NOT block the sidewalk.</u>
- Leaves only—please remove sticks, rocks, trash, and other debris.
- Do not block the leaf row with vehicles on collection day.
