Annual Meeting

The Stratford Gardens Annual Meeting was held at Mission Hills Country Club on Thursday evening, May 21st. Paul Mohr started by summarizing the highlights of the past year, Maggie Shine introduced the proposed budget for the new fiscal year, new board members were elected, and the guest speaker was Troy Schulte, the KC Budget Officer.

Troy Schulte spoke on the topic of "The Road Ahead: Insights into the City Budget." Mr. Schulte provided a highly informative and engaging presentation on the city's \$1.3 billion budget and the sources of and allocations of funds. He noted that while Kansas City has been less adversely impacted by economic conditions than most regions of the country, it typically also takes longer to come out of a recession than many other cities. He noted that additional budget cutbacks in 2010 may well be required.

Financial Update

You should have received your bill for the 2009/2010 dues in early June. If you have not received this, please contact the HACCD office at 913-385-2440. Please pay your bill on time to avoid any late payment fees.

We ended the fiscal year with a budget surplus of \$7,496.52. These funds have been evenly split, with half put into the Capital Improvement Fund and half into the Association Reserve account (a certificate of deposit). Islands and Common Areas Update

A one (1) year contract for the maintenance of our islands was signed in June. Constant Care is our contractor, and they are responsible for mowing, trimming, fertilizing, and maintenance of the sprinkler systems.

PIAC Island Project

63rd Street Island Improvement Project: In Spring 2008, the Association was awarded a \$29,000 grant from the city's Public Improvement Advisory Committee (PIAC). Project planning has been underway, including historical research; meetings and discussions with city staff, landscape architects, and contractors; physical exploratory analysis and investigations; and development of bid-ready project specifications. The project plans were submitted to the City in June and we are waiting for the approval.

Security Update

Speed Traps

The Metro Traffic Department and our security force have been informed of speeding on a number of our streets, specifically 61st Street, 61st Terrace, 62nd Street and 63rd Street. After discussing our concern with the Traffic Department, they agreed to conduct random speed traps on the above mentioned streets for the first 2 weeks of July. The location, time and street will not be constant and hopefully, it will curtail the speeding in our area. Please watch your speed and do not be caught in the speed trap!

Crime Alerts

As mentioned in numerous emails and previous newsletters, it is our obligation to inform you of any and all crime alerts in our area. We do this via the email system, so those members without email alerts are at a disadvantage. Please be sure to discuss the issue with your neighbors since it would be extremely costly to send out all notices via post, and we want to make sure all are informed and safe.

By entering in the zip code "64113" you can view the activity in our area. I am pleased to say that the security patrol and few Neighborhood Watch blocks in our association have minimized crime in Stratford Gardens! Unfortunately, that is not the case with associations east of Ward Parkway.

Reporting Activity

The police have repeatedly and quite strongly requested that if you witness suspicious activity, or are awakened during the night by noise or disturbances; *do not hesitate to call 911 immediately*. If our patrol officer is on duty, they will be dispatched and given their proximity should provide assistance quickly.

Summer Parties

With summer parties in full swing, please be considerate of your neighbors with respect to noise, loud music, parking and other disturbances. If you are planning a party, we suggest that you inform your neighbors of the event. Everyone will appreciate the "heads up". Simple courtesy and neighborliness can go a long way toward minimizing conflict.

Parking is a big issue on our narrow streets, so it will be appreciated if you ask your guests to park in a manner that does not inconvenience neighbors. If you note that parking would prohibit an emergency vehicle from entering your street, notify 911 immediately. As a courtesy we suggest that you inform your neighbor as well so that they don't feel blind-sided by a 911 call.

It will be held at Hale Cook School - 73rd and Pennsylvania. As you clean up your basements and garages, please consider this event for the proper disposal of your hazardous/household waste.

See details below for acceptable items, but please note:

- * 300-car limit (Event ends at noon or when the 300 car limit is met)
- * ID is required (the association has paid the fee to participate)
- * No business waste is accepted
- * No containers larger than 5 gallon buckets accepted
- * Traffic enters on Pennsylvania, exits on Jefferson

Although we are sponsoring the event with other associations, we ask that a <u>donation of 1 can of</u> food (minimum) or \$1.00 be donated for local food pantries.
