Financial Update

You should have received your bill for the 2010/2011 dues in early June. If you have not received this, please contact the HAKC office at 913-385-2440. Please pay your bill on time to avoid any late payment fees.

We ended the fiscal year with a budget surplus of \$6,578.73. These funds have been evenly split, with half put into the Capital Improvement Fund and half into the Association Reserve account. Islands and Common Areas Update

Bids were solicited for the island maintenance contract. A one (1) year contract for the maintenance of our islands was signed in June. Constant Care is our contractor, and they are responsible for mowing, trimming, fertilizing, and maintenance of the sprinkler systems.

63rd Street and State Line Island – PIAC update

In the spring of 2008, the Association was awarded a \$29,000 grant from the city's Public Improvement Advisory Committee (PIAC) to repair, refurbish and improve the island. The project has been completed and a re-dedication ceremony was held on August 31st. We would like to thank Paul Moore, the past board members, and everyone who contributed to make this project possible. The island looks wonderful and will continue to be an asset to the neighborhood.

Security Update

Crime Alerts

As mentioned in numerous emails and previous newsletters, it is our obligation to inform you of any and all crime alerts in our area. We do this via the email system, so those members without email alerts are at a disadvantage. Please be sure to discuss the issue with your neighbors since it would be extremely costly to send out all notices via post, and we want to make sure all are informed and safe.

Reporting Activity

The police have repeatedly and quite strongly requested that if you witness suspicious activity, or are awakened during the night by noise or disturbances; *do not hesitate to call 911 immediately*. If our patrol officer is on duty, they will be dispatched and given their proximity should provide assistance quickly.

Holiday Parties

With holiday parties starting soon, please be considerate of your neighbors with respect to noise, loud music, parking and other disturbances. If you are planning a party, we suggest that you inform your neighbors of the event. Everyone will appreciate the "heads up". Simple courtesy and neighborliness can go a long way toward minimizing conflict.

Parking is a big issue on our narrow streets, so it will be appreciated if you ask your guests to park in a manner that does not inconvenience neighbors. If you note that parking would prohibit an emergency vehicle from entering your street, notify 911 immediately. As a courtesy we suggest that you inform your neighbor as well so that they don't feel blind-sided by a 911 call.

<u>Leaves and Grass Clippings</u>

We have had reports that some lawn care services are blowing leaves and grass clippings into the street, instead of onto the lawn. If you have a hired service to tend to your lawn, please ask them to not do this since the leaves clog up storm sewers, which can have serious consequences to you and your neighbors. The City provides free curbside pickup of up to 20 paper sacks of leaves or bundles of brush (excluding grass clippings) twice a year. The next date for collection is December 10th for most of our area.
