'Slow' Signs on St. Andrews Drive and 'Yield' Signs around the Neighborhood

Many residents have complained that drivers speed on St. Andrews Drive.

- 'Slow' signs have been posted.
- Locations for 'Slow-Children Playing' signs were determined and sent to the City for installation.
- Locations for 'Yield' signs were also determined and sent to the City for installation.
- To date, the City has installed three (3) 'Yield' signs.
- Still waiting for the City to install the additional requested street signs.

Snow Plowing

• Due to our mild winter, we fortunately did not incur any snow plowing expenses for the 2011-2012 season.

Island Maintenance

- Alan Gallas will request Ultra Lawns to submit a bid for 2012 Island Maintenance.
- The Board also discussed paying willing homeowners located near islands to do the maintenance for the island near them. This would include mowing, trimming, watering, weed removal, fertilizing, etc.

Treasurer's Report

• Alan Gallas/Karen Wood-Nelson presented the Treasurer's report through February 28, 2012.

Neighborhood Nuisances

• Parked cars around the cul-de-sacs and along the street on St. Andrews Drive continue to generate complaints. Due to St. Andrews Drive being a narrow street, this is a driving hazard. The KCMO police have agreed to be more vigilant on this issue in the days ahead. Street and cul-de-sac parking may result in the receipt of a traffic citation from the City. Please park in your driveways.

Public Improvement Advisory Committee (PIAC)

• The Public Improvements Advisory Committee (PIAC) requests submitted by Steve Rinne in 2011 are still active. We are awaiting word on their status.

Signing up Non-Association Members

• There are currently ten (10) homeowners in Blue Hills Estates that are not members of the Blue Hills Estates Homes Association and, as a result, do not pay the \$75 annual Association Dues. They are getting all the benefits of the Homes Association without paying any dues. Since our dues are capped at \$75 a year and costs keep rising, the Board would like all homes in Blue Hills Estates to join the Association and pay the annual dues.

Review Blue Hills Estates Plot Map and Verbiage

• An updated Blue Hills Estates Neighborhood Association map as been developed. In addition to showing the street boundaries, it also includes a verbal description of the Association boundaries.

Delinquent Home Owners Association Dues

• There are four (4) homeowners in the Association that are delinquent on their 2011-2012 Annual Homes Association Dues. Delinquency letters have been issued.
