The meeting was called to order at 6:10pm by President Tom Brill. Last year's General Meeting Minutes were moved for approval by Bob Stopperan, seconded by Gregg Davidson and passed unanimously.

Mr. Davidson presented the treasurer's report.

Police Chief Wes Jordan spoke about crime trends within the city and how each resident can help play a role in the reduction of city crime. Chief Jordan thanked Mission Hills City Council and the staff at City Hall for their continued support.

Mrs. Marsh reported on projects completed in 2009 and those hope to be completed in 2010. There were questions about tree trimming and members wanted to know if perhaps a group discount might be available for those of us within the Association wanting our trees trimmed. City Administrator, Courtney Christensen reported that Mission Hill's city trees are pruned every 5-10 years. Further discussion about a tree trimming proposal will be discussed at the next Board of Directors meeting.
