Budget

Jake Schulzinger reviewed current budget. He has not received bill for lawn maintenance. Deffenbaugh

trash collections fees increased slightly in March.

Item will be included in newsletter informing residents of trimming responsibility for those with trees

overhanging sidewalks.

Doug will ask for quote from Summit for trimming trees and board will discuss further.

There have been some complaints from residents regarding Summit. When complaints are received, notes will be taken and addressed with Summit contact.

Grub application, weed & feed, and fungicide will be applied on the 22^{nd} . These treatments, especially the fungicide should help brown appearance of lawn due to lithium.
