Guidelines for Curbside Placement of Trash

General Trash Guidelines: It is important for all residents to follow the City rules on putting out our trash. Your trash items may only be placed on the curbside on Sunday prior to the scheduled Monday pickup. Please do not placed any items on the curb prior to Sunday. It detracts from the neighborhood and is a violation of the City trash guidelines.

Large items can be picked up any time of year by scheduling in advance with Deffenbaugh at 913-631-3300. There is a nominal service fee. Items to be included: appliances, furniture, remodeling debris and other unusual items. Free large item pick-up by the city for addresses East of Antioch will resume in Spring 2009.
