Crime Prevention & Community Awareness

The OMG Crime Prevention and Community Awareness program is designed to keep residents informed about neighborhood crime and/or suspicious activity. The program assigns volunteer "Block Captains" on each street to disseminate this information among their neighbors.

To prevent crime, one of the most important things we can do is report suspicious activity. If you believe the call warrants immediate attention, dial 911. If the situation is not life threatening, but does require a police officer to be dispatched, call the *non-emergency number at 816-234-5111*.

Free Christmas Tree Pickup

Have your Christmas tree hauled away at no charge by having it at the curb no later than 8am Monday, January 4th. The tree must be bare, and have no lights, tinsel, or lights. *Please note this service is for Christmas trees only - no brush or other debris will be picked up.*

Curbside Brush & Leaf Pickup

The city collects up to 20 sacks or bundles of leaves and brush (excluding grass clippings) from residences during scheduled curbside collections in the spring and fall. Homes in OMG are on the *South Schedule*, and there are two scheduled pickups this fall (see chart to the right).

OMG Real Estate Market Update

According to recent statistics*, the OMG real estate market is healthy. Over the last six months, there were 15 sales, with an average sales price of \$201,733, which is normal based on past years. Currently there are 11 homes actively for sale, and 6 under contract. Analysis of these numbers reveals that we have a healthy *sales rate*, with only 4.4 months worth of inventory on the market. Anything less than 6 months of inventory on the market indicates a balanced market, which is great news.

It is probable that the government tax credit is giving our market a

boost, especially since our pricerange is popular among first-time buyers. Also helping keep sales flowing are the historically low interest rates. It is a good time to sell - especially if you have a well-maintained home. Those are being snatched up faster than ever.
