# Great News for Our Senior Neighbors: Property Tax Freeze Expanded

Big news for homeowners in our neighborhood who are 62 and older: Missouri has just made it easier to freeze your property taxes at 2024 levels, thanks to a new law that expands the senior tax freeze program.

Applying is simple: You can fill out the application online, mail it in, or drop it off at one of the county offices. All you need is proof of age, residency, and that you're responsible for your home's property taxes. ## Is Your Insurance Prepared for Potential Water and Sewer Line Issues?

Many Westwood Park homes are still connected to original water & sewer lines, nearly 100 years old. While the Kansas City Water Department maintains the water lines from the main to the curb stop, homeowners are responsible for costs and upkeep from the curb stop to the house and for sewer lines, you own the connection from your home to the sewer main.

The bottom line: as homeowners, we're on the hook for some repairs. Here's two tips to consider to minimize your risk. Keep wipes, grease, and non-soluble items out of drains to avoid problems

Consider adding a rider to your home insurance or purchasing an exterior service line policy to cover potential repairs or replacements.




# Make plans for the KC Plaza Art Fair

# New Speed Humps Coming to Kansas City — and we made the list!

Good news for our neighborhood: Kansas City is making streets safer by installing 100 speed humps at 50 locations citywide—and Westwood Park is on the list! This new traffic calming measure is part of the city's Vision Zero initiative, which aims to eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries by 2030.

Two new speed humps were installed across Westwood Road near 49th and Wyoming. It's important to note that the city, not the Homeowner's Association, chose these locations based on safety data and proximity to high-risk areas. The goal is to create safer streets, especially near schools, parks and accident-prone areas. Keep an eye out for these changes, and let's all do our part to keep our neighborhood safe.
