Key Initiatives

• Neighborhood Conservation Overlay District Proposal and Updates—A committee including Margaret Smith, Steve Weneck, Mike Posten, and Richard Farnan has been working with the City to establish reasonable limits and rules for future new construction in Westwood Park so that we maintain the neighborhood's wonderful ambiance. A neighborhood meeting to review the proposed draft has been scheduled for Saturday morning, March 19 from 10:00 to 11:30 at Patterson Hall, accessible through the Hall Student Center entrance on the Pembroke Hill Campus. A majority of residents would have to approve the changes to amend the zoning ordinance and implement the Neighborhood Conservation Overlay District. Stay tuned for updates as the process moves forward! Thanks to all involved for working hard to preserve the charm of Westwood Park!

Speed bumps—Spearheaded by Elizabeth and Jeff Corder. They have canvassed and
received approval from the majority of residents on Westwood Road to add speed
bumps to slow down the traffic. The next step is that the City must conduct an analysis
of traffic patterns for that street to determine if usage meets City requirements to add

Things to Know

- City garbage and recycling pick up is on Friday mornings- Check <u>www.kcmo.gov</u> for holiday schedules. You can put out a maximum of 2 bags of trash (or more bags if you attach trash tags for each additional bag-tags available at Price Chopper on 103rd off of State Line). There is no limit to recycling for newspapers, cardboard, and plastic. (You can take glass for recycling to a Ripple Glass Recycling Dumpster located by Marsh's Sun Fresh Market at 4001 Mill Street, KCMO)
- We try to schedule two Westwood Park Dumpster Days per year, one occurs in June and usually one in November, both on Saturdays. However, these are popular events scheduled with City departments and dates may vary. Dates will be announced prior to each event. Two dumpsters are provided: One dumpster is for unwanted items; one is for yard waste.
- There are two City yard waste days per year where you can put out up to 20 yard waste bags. The spring date in 2022 is Friday, April 1. The fall date is Friday, December 23. You can check this information on kcmo.gov/city-hall/trash/leafandbrush. (This web site also explains bulky item pick up rules, where you can drop off yard waste, where you can recycle hazardous wastes like paint, and the rules for each.)
- Suburban Lawn and Garden also has a reasonably priced yard waste drop off center at 135th and Wornall.

 There are also yard waste companies that will pick up yard waste on a weekly basis for a fee. Compost Connection (compostconnection.com) is one of those available in our area.

Reminders

- When the weather warms up, and we're able to get out more and walk the dogs, please remember to pick up after those very regular canines. You can grab handy poop bags at several locations in the park. Thanks!
- Also, when spring finally gets here down the road, please keep those gutters clean so rainwater has somewhere to flow. Thanks!
